## **Product Description**

saveBOARD betterJOINERY Ultima Laminate is a unique structural composite panel made from 99% recycled materials.

The core of the product is made from shredded and compressed composite packaging (aka tetra pak) and soft plastic and can be used as a substrate for the range of Ultima laminates.

saveBOARD does not use glues, resins or other such biological or environmentally harmful products. During construction, or in-service use saveBOARD does not create harmful dust, vapours, or other potentially harmful Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC's).

betterJOINERY Ultima Laminate substrate is finished with a recycled paper face and back.

betterJOINERY Ultima Laminate sheets are manufactured in New Zealand & Australia for exclusive use in both countries.
